Compare and Contrast Chart Activities

Whole Class or Large Group T-Chart or 3 Column Chart

Model and/or work together to chart the similarities and/or differences of various things. [characters, books, settings, book vs. movie, pets, animals, pictures, real animals vs. animals in a story, songs, solutions to similar problems in stories, etc.]

Centers or Small Group T-Chart

Students choose a way to sort the images, Similar or Different. Then, students sort the images, placing them in groups based on either their similarities or differences and explain their decisions.

Independent Work

Students work on a chart [2 or 3 columns] comparing the specified things [books, characters,...] from from their reading.
