## The Essential Phonemic Awareness Cheat Sheet

**Phonemic awareness is...** the ability to hear, differentiate and flexibly manipulate units of sound in **spoken language.** No letters are used in phonemic awareness instruction.

## The 5 Phonemic Awareness Skills:

- Separating: s-l-o-p
- Blending: s-l-o-p...sl-op...slop
- Substituting: slop...slap
- Deleting: slap...lap
- Adding: lap...flap

## Clues to Phonemic Awareness Deficiency:

- Trouble Rhyming
- Lack of Fluency in Reading
- Cannot Hear Letter Blends [beginning and/or ending]
- Spelling memorizes whole words, not flexile with applying units of sound
- Decoding re-decodes the same word(s) every time they encounter them in the same text. Struggles to accurately decode unknown words.
